I have not spoken to you for some time, so I hope your doing well. The Fort Lytton Moto-cross facility is still operating but with the same problem.

This letter is a follow on to the previous letter dating back to 4th April 2006.

I had a informed meeting with Mrs. Deborah Wood who is the newly appointed property manger from the Port of Brisbane on the 16th February 2007.

Mrs. Wood informed me that the Fort Lytton Moto-cross clubs permit was up for the renewal in March 2007 and the permit would be extended only for a short term, as the Port is planning to develop the site.

I enquired if the port has any other land allocated for the Fort Lytton clubs relocation. Mrs. Wood mentioned she was going to investigate that possibility.

I'm sure you would agree, the Fort Lytton Moto-cross clubs facility which is used by riders from all over the country, can't use the mentality of "Just wait and see if the club closes down due to land development". The community needs your support in finding a long term site in the Brisbane Metropolitan area.
